JOINTLY DEVELOPED

The parents, students, and staff of the McCloskey School partnered together to develop this school-parent compact for achievement. Teachers suggested home learning strategies, parents added input about the types of support they needed, and students told us what would help them learn. Parents are encouraged to attend annual revision meetings held in the spring each year to review the compact and make suggestions based on student needs and school improvement goals. This year, that parent input meeting was held on May 11, 2020. Parents are also encouraged to participate in the School Family Engagement survey that is also used as a tool to collect parent feedback regarding the current Title I program, policies, and family engagement.

- At least 60% of students will attend school 95% of days or more.
- At least 70% of Kindergarten students and 50% of 1st and 2nd-grade students will score at the target by the Spring aimswebPlus assessment.
- At least 60% of students in grades 4-5 will score at grade level by the Spring aimswebPlus assessment.
- At least 75% of students in grades 6-8 will earn As and Bs in all core courses.
- At least 90% of students in grades 6-8 will have zero out-of-school suspensions.

- Monitor attendance.
- Make sure that homework is completed, checked and signed.
- Monitor the amount of television my child watches.
- Participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my child's education.
- Promote positive use of my child's extracurricular time.
- Stay informed about my child's education and communicate with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district either received by my child or by mail and responding, as appropriate.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Arrive on time and be prepared to participate in lessons.
- Follow school rules.
- Do my homework every day and ask for help when I need it.
- Read at least 30 minutes every day outside of school time.
- Give to my parents or guardian all notices and information received by me from my school every day.
